Week 6: Authority & Hearing God's Voice (Part 1)

Introduction - We are both in authority and under authority

"Miriam and Aaron began to talk against Moses because of his Cushite wife, for he had married a Cushite. "Has the Lord spoken only through Moses?" they asked. "Hasn't he also spoken through us?" And the Lord heard this.

(Now Moses was a very humble man, more humble than anyone else on the face of the earth.)

At once the Lord said to Moses, Aaron and Miriam, "Come out to the tent of meeting, all three of you." So the three of them went out. Then the Lord came down in a pillar of cloud; he stood at the entrance to the tent and summoned Aaron and Miriam. When the two of them stepped forward, he said, "Listen to my words:

"When there is a prophet among you,
I, the Lord, reveal myself to them in visions,
I speak to them in dreams.

But this is not true of my servant Moses;
he is faithful in all my house.

With him I speak face to face,
clearly and not in riddles;
he sees the form of the Lord.

So Moses cried out to the Lord, "Please, God, heal her!"



Unbelief

- I don't believe that God is going to speak to me.
- I don't believe that I can hear God's voice.

Fear

- I'm anxious that I'll get it wrong.
- I'm worried about what the other team members think of me.

Insignificance

- I'm not really needed on the team.
- What I've heard won't be taken seriously

Pride

- I can hear God better than that person.
- I don't need to do it that way.

Before you come to ask God questions, ensure that you have allowed God to search your heart and deal with any sin that would limit you hearing God's voice that day.
